



# 30% CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

## Terms and Conditions 2024/25

### Eligibility

1. Applicants must intend to pursue a part-time Taught Master's degree during the 2024 - 2025 Academic Year in one of the following:

- MSc Strategy & Innovation
- MSc Design Innovation
- MSc Finance
- MSc Business Analytics
- Master of Science Business

2. Meet the academic entry requirements for their programme of choice (available on the Maynooth University website)

To apply, applicants must submit the following:

1. A completed Application Form
2. A current professional CV
3. A personal statement outlining their commitment to undertaking part time study, how their chosen programme will support their own professional development and how they have demonstrated a commitment to advancing gender equality, in line with the 30% Club aims.
4. Confirm they are a citizen of an EEA member state or Switzerland AND resident in Ireland or Northern Ireland for 3 years or more. Non-EEA citizens should contact the Graduate Studies Office ([pgstudies@mu.ie](mailto:pgstudies@mu.ie)) to confirm eligibility.
5. Submit their application to the Graduate Studies Office [pgstudies@mu.ie](mailto:pgstudies@mu.ie) by 30<sup>th</sup> June 2024.

### Ineligibility

Current students of PhD or Research Master's programmes are not eligible to apply. Prospective students interested in research programmes should apply instead for the Maynooth University John and Pat Hume Doctoral Research Awards.

### **Value of the Scholarship**

Maynooth University may offer one full-fee scholarship to undertake part-time study during the 2024/2025 Academic Year in one of the following:

- MSc Strategy & Innovation
- MSc Design Innovation
- MSc Finance
- MSc Business Analytics
- Master of Science Business

### **Scholarship assessment**

An initial eligibility check will be undertaken by the Graduate Studies Office to ensure that applications have met the eligibility requirements.

Eligible applications will be reviewed by an academic panel. The panel will rank the applications using the following marking scheme:

1. Professional experience – 40%
2. Personal statement – 40%
3. Academic attainment – 20%

### **Miscellaneous**

The scholarship may not be deferred.

### **Closing Date**

Completed applications should be submitted via email by the closing date of the 30<sup>th</sup> **June 2024**. Applications may be submitted any time before the closing date.

Late applications will not be accepted.
