Conflict Analysis: Stabilisation and the Comprehensive Approach

Module MC632 – EQF Level 9



Dates: Wednesday 9th, Thursday 10th, Friday 11th May 2018

This three-day course will allow participants to develop core skills in conflict analysis tools, assessing the different characteristics of conflict intervention in a structured way. The course explores the important dimensions of conflict analysis (actors, dynamics, issues, strategies) while also addressing international organisations, stabilisation and the comprehensive approach.

Given the multi-dimensional nature of conflict prevention and peacebuilding, practitioners, policymakers, academics all face extraordinary challenges. This course provides the analytical tools that will enable individuals working in this field with the necessary skills to carry out their work more effectively.

The programme is comprised of seminars as well as presentations and conversations with guest lecturers. Participants will develop substantial knowledge, understanding and proficiencies in identifying interventions appropriate to different phases of a conflict, illustrating analytical tools used, with reference to case studies.

Venue: This course will be run by the Kennedy Institute, Maynooth University.
