

Digital Technologies in Higher Education (10 ECTS)

Call for Applications 2022/23

The Centre for Teaching and Learning is delighted to offer Maynooth University teaching staff the opportunity to enhance their digital teaching and learning competencies through participation in module TL517/TL517X: Digital Technologies in Higher Education. This module forms part of Maynooth University's Postgraduate Diploma in Higher Education Teaching, Learning and Assessment (PDHETL) and will be offered as an accredited stand-alone module that will run over Semester 2 (TL517X) of the 2022/23 academic year.

The module aims to give participants an understanding of the contemporary landscape with respect to digital technologies and higher education teaching and learning. Participants will have practical opportunities to design, implement, and reflect on the use of digital technologies for learning, assessment, and feedback in their own teaching contexts. Through engaging with the module curriculum, participants will develop competencies in line with the European Framework for the Digital Competence for Educators (DigCompEdu). Participants who successfully complete the module and subsequently enrol on the PDHETL may apply for an exemption from the module (subject to relevant timeframes).

Teaching and Learning Approach and Participation Requirements

It will be predominantly delivered online via a combination of asynchronous and synchronous learning resources and activities including key readings; videos; podcasts; online seminars; individual activities; and group discussions and activities. In addition, a maximum of one-two in-person workshops may be offered to support participant learning. As a 10-credit module, it will require approximately 200-250 hours of participant effort.

Eligibility

Participation in the module requires a teaching context to facilitate participants to contextualise and apply their learning, and to meet the module learning outcomes. It is therefore essential that those applying for the module are teaching and assessing in a higher education context.

Module Fee

There is no fee for Maynooth University Teaching Staff who wish to register for this module for Semester 2 of the 2022/23 academic year. To be eligible for the fee waiver participants must hold a contract with the university for the duration of the module. For staff who are employed on a temporary contract, the length of their contract must exceed the expected end date of the module.
