1. National secretariat e.g. SAR Germany (w/Humboldt Foundation), SAR Finland (w/Universities Finland (UNIFI)

2. Steering committee & Chair e.g. SAR Norway., 5 to 7 reps elected to serve on steering committee for 2 years

3. Partner NGO: e.g. UK (Cara) which has a long history of supporting refugee and at-risk scholars
