They are designed to

- > build institutional capacity in teaching and learning
- address teaching and learning themes of strategic importance to the University
- recognise individuals and teams for their contribution to teaching and learning enhancement across the University.

T&L project	One small change



T&L Fellowships and SPARK 2024-25 – shared features

Theme: 'Valuing Teaching and Learning: Action, Enquiry, Inspiration'.

All staff who teach may apply. All applications are online through Forms.

Individual or team, department, inter-department, or between departments and units/centres. Students as partners welcome.

All applications judged against published call criteria. Advice for all

- write in plain English for an intelligent reader but also someone who may not be from your discipline
- ensure that the project is feasible
- work within the word counts noted in the application form.

All successful applicants need to write a report and participate in the T&L Showcase.

Deadline for completion of work and funding spent **30 August 2025**.

Funding to be spent in line with University financial and other relevant procedures.

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Spark Initiative - Change One Thing

The CTL 2024 SPARK Initiative aims to support individual staff and teams in implementing small-scale Teaching and Learning enhancement projects. The idea behind SPARK is to identify one aspect of your Teaching and Learning that you would like to enhance and to begin to address this issue with a starter project that creates opportunity to build on the initiative beyond the funding timeframe. The funding's motto captures the spirit of the initiative: '*Change one thing*'.

Examples of previous projects are available in the <u>SPARK Initiative report 2021</u> and the <u>SPARK Initiative Report 2022-</u> 23.

Theme and Funding

The theme for this year's SPARK call is the same as the T&L Fellowship 2024-25 theme: **'Valuing Teaching and Learning:** Action, Enquiry, Inspiration'.

This year, there are up to **10 grants of €1,000** available for individuals/teams

How can the funding be used?

- staff time (including the buying out of staff time)
- the production of resources
- catering and events
- guest speakers/expert input
- travel and subsistence
- conference fees
- the purchase of equipment and/or software
- other reasonable expenses as approved by the review panel.

All spending, and recording of same, should conform with University procedures and processes, including those associated with recruitment and procurement.



Review criteria: T&L Fellowships 2024-25

- alignment with the theme
- alignment with University/department plans/strategies
- evidence based and/or practice informed nature of proposal and its implementation
- clarity and feasibility of project plan
- costing of the plan
- potential for sustainability and mainstreaming across the department or development of the project beyond the Fellowship.



Review criteria: SPARK 2024-25

- be narrow in focus i.e. associated with one small change/enhancement to teaching/learning/assessment
- be informed by literature or recognised good practice in teaching and learning
- contribution to student learning
- process and timeline for planning, implementation, and evaluation of the initiative
- breakdown of how the €1,000 grant will be spent.
