- 3 Students entering MH103 (Music) and MH116 (Community and Youth Work - full-time) will receive DARE and HEAR post entry supports.
- 4 Applicants with a physical or sensory disability or applicants who are eligible for both DARE and HEAR are prioritised first when making reduced points offers.
