

### **Mid-Career Planning for Retirement**

Mid-career Planning for Retirement is a course organized by Learning & Development, HR and facilitated by the Retirement Planning Council (RPC)

This course is aimed at MU staff who are at the mid-point in their career (age bracket c35 - 50 years).

#### Post Course Support:

All course participants are entitled to lifetime access to the Executive Coach and Specialist Speakers after they have completed the course. This is to allow people to pose questions they may not feel comfortable discussing in a group setting. It also provides an opportunity for participants to address issues that might arise on reflection after they have attended the course. This service is free.
