This Masters programme offers a rewarding learning experience for those who wish to work in development and peacebuilding in conflict and post-conflict contexts.

Integrating negotiation and peacebuilding skills with an analysis of wider conflict and development contexts, it provides critical insight into international conflict interventions. This includes theory, strategies and practices which focus on contemporary global challenges such as resource conflict and human rights violations. It also addresses the role of governments, civil society and participatory peace processes.

Drawing on insights from peace education, human security and community development, it challenges top-down imposed solutions and examines what's involved in community led processes of change and peacebuilding in a variety of settings.

The Department of International Development

applies a person-centred and flexible approach to learning. Drawing on the experience of a diverse group of full-time and part-time learners, including a significant number of international students, a unique learning environment is created that builds on participants' knowledge and the experience of academic staff.
