### **Creation of PAUSE**

August 2015 :Assassination of Khaled Al-Asaad, the former director of antiquities and museums of Palmyra in Syria, and mobilization of the archaeological community

October 2016 :Announcement of the creation of a reception mechanism for researchers in exile and creation of a support committee during the Collège de France's annual conference on "Migration, refugees, exile".

January 2017 :Official launch of PAUSEwith the signing of the framework agreement between the Ministry of, Higher Education and Research, the Collège de France and the Chancellerie des Universités de Paris



Missions

- **Co-funding of institutions** seeking to host a scientist or artist forced into exile through three calls for applications per year.
- Support for researchers with identifying a host institution and accessing common law services
- Accompaniment of researchers towards a sustainable professional insertion.
- Advocacy actions to uphold academic freedom and protect researchers in exile.
- International and European cooperation with similar programs abroad and stakeholders working to help at -risk researchers.




