Students over 23 & Living Independently & not in receipt of SUSI*:

Living independently has a strict definition: it means you are not residing at the family home since at least the October of the **year before** the year entry to university and that you receive no financial support from your parents/guardians whatsoever. If you qualify under this definition, you should provide the following income documents for all income earners in your own household:

- 1. **Income documents** for the full year ending 2022. Refer to the table above to find out which document.
- Proof of mortgage/ rental (copy of your mortgage statement/ signed lease or rent book or other proof of rent dated from at least October of the year prior to entry to university or earlier if possible).
- Recent utility bill at your current address (a mobile phone bill is not acceptable).

*Household income documents required if over 23 and living with parents/guardians & not on SUSI? You should provide your parents'/guardians' Household Income Documents as listed in the table above.
