She previously held tenured positions at Monash University in Australia and Victoria University of Wellington in New Zealand. Her interests center on cross-national large-scale research on global (virtual) teams, global and cross-cultural leadership, cultural values, language and distance factors in international business. Her work has been published in journals such as *Journal of World Business, Journal of Business Ethics, Management International Review, International Business Review*, and others. Audra serves on the editorial boards of *Journal of World Business, Thunderbird International Business Review*, and *Baltic Journal of Management* (Associate Editor).
