Critical Skills Online Summer 2020 Classes

The Critical Skills online summer module is a compressed course that will run from July 20 through August 21. This year students will use their academic interests to build an imaginary world as part of a team project. This is a 100% online course. It is structured into weekly units that you can complete at your own pace. This is a writing intensive course that will build methodological, information, teamwork, and communication skills.

Logistics

1 How much does it cost?

The cost per Critical Skills Summer Module in 2020 will be €435. Students can register for a maximum of one Critical Skills Summer Module (SK105 or SK106).

2. How to register for the course?

Students will register for the Critical Skills Summer Module via a webform. The webform will be made available on our website https://www.maynoothuniversity.ie/critical-skills/critical-skills-summer-school-2020

Registration opens Friday, 3 July. Registration will close at 5:00 pm on Wednesday 15 July. Applications will not be accepted after this date.

3. When will I know if I have a place on the Critical Skills summer school and which group I am in?

You will receive an email notification and be added to a course Moodle page.

Eligibility

- 1. I took Critical Skills as a first-year subject can I now take the summer module to make up for a different subject/module I did not pass?

 Students who studied Critical Skills as a Year 1 subject are not eligible to take a Critical Skills Summer Module as they have completed both modules already.
- 2. I did not pass Critical Skills—do I take the summer class?

If you did not pass Critical Skills and then you may complete a "supplemental assessment" to pass the class. You should do this rather than repeat the class. You will receive an email from Critical Skills on July 3.

3. I took SK105 in semester 2 can I take SK106 in the summer?

Students who completed SK105 in semester 2 may choose to study Critical Skills Summer Module SK106 as they have not already taken SK106 this academic year.

4. Can I register for both Critical Skills Summer Modules?

Students may register for either Critical Skills Summer Module SK105 or SK106 but not both as the modules will be taught at the same time and SK105 is a prerequisite for SK106.

5. Critical Skills was not available to me as a choice within my programme; can I take the summer module?

The Critical Skills Modules are available to students for whom Critical Skills was a subject choice in first year. To confirm if Critical Skills was a subject choice for your programme please check your programme on Coursefinder.

Other Questions

1. I am not sure if I should take the Critical Skills summer module or sit the repeat exam for a module I did not pass; can I speak to someone about it?

Students are advised to speak to their lecturers and departments in the first instance. The University will host a 'Consultation Day' on 7 July 2020 - staff will be available in all Departments to discuss results with students.
