Travelling to Maynooth by Plane

Travelling from Dublin Airport to Maynooth

Travelling from Dublin City to Maynooth by Train

Maynooth lies on the Western Suburban railway line, which serves the four Dublin city centre stations (Pearse Station, Tara St, Connolly Station and Docklands) as well as twelve other suburban stations.
