### Off-Campus Accommodation – Homefinder Service

[Homefinder](#) is a service offered by the [Student Support Hub](#). It is an information service and runs a database – [Maynooth Studentpad](#) – for local homeowners and landlords to connect with students.

The Studentpad database is only available to registered students of MU and SPCM (St. Patrick's College Maynooth). Registered students must sign-up using their @mumail.ie or @spcm.ie email address. Studentpad is self-service and properties advertised are **not** inspected by the University. Accommodation advertised on the Studentpad will go live at different times of the year. As MU is located in a residential area, the majority of accommodation offered is within owner occupied homes. Accommodation from towns close to Maynooth are also advertised. There is information on the website on options to travel to Maynooth from surrounding towns.
