This **20 credit certificate** is available to students visiting Maynooth University for a **single semester** (semester 1 or 2) and for the **full academic year**.

It would be suitable for students in public health, health sciences, international relations/development and global health practices.

Courses will be offered from **various departments**: Anthropology, International Development, Geography, History, Sociology and Politics.
