Proposed department, PhD supervisor and supervisor's statement of support.	Upload confirmation of support provided by your proposed Supervisor. Please note the supervisor's statement does not constitute an "additional" reference. You should provide the following two optional responses to your proposed supervisor for them to reply back to you with. 1. "I am willing to supervise this applicant subject to them being offered a Hume award." or 2. "I am not in a position to supervise this applicant" .
Award Type	Only applicable if you are selecting, MU Women In STEM, Fee Waiver Scholarship (only) and Maynooth Access Programme (MAP) scholarship.
Previous awards/achievements	Ensure section is complete.
Research project title	Ensure section is complete.
Abstract	Abstract should not exceed 300 words.
Research project proposal	Upload research project proposal , maximum of 4 pages, plus 3 pages for charts, graphs bibliography. 4 + 3 = 7 pages in total
Maynooth Access Programme	This section will only appear to applicants who indicate they wish to apply for the MAP scholarship.
Personal statement/Fit of Applicant/Plan for Dissemination of Research	Should not exceed 500 words overall For Personal Statement. 300 words overall for Fit of Applicant and 300 words overall for Plan for Dissemination of Research. (1,100 in total)
Applicant's declaration	Applicants must declare that the application is their own work, information provided correct and that they accept the scheme's terms and conditions. ***Scroll down for last item on check list***

Information about referees	All applicants are also required to make arrangements with two nominated referees who will provide a reference. References must be provided on a specific form available on Maynooth University Graduate studies website and should be provided directly by referees online via the online application system. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that referees submit their reference on time before the specified deadline.
