Project Title:

Using History and Biography to Increase Awareness of Diversity in Mathematics and Statistics

Project Description:

For this proposed Internship, the student(s) would work on the development of a series of resources which would be used to highlight the rich diversity and history of mathematics and statistics.

The content and specific details of these resources will be chosen by the students themselves, subject to the agreement of the Internship Supervisors. One possible route is to develop a series of interactive posters which focus on celebrating the life and achievements of specific (often less celebrated or commonly known) individuals, while also linking to other resources such as videos\podcasts etc. See for example: <u>Argelia Vélez-Rodríguez</u>, from a similar project at Queen Mary University of London.

It is anticipated that these posters will be displayed in the Department, placed on our website, and incorporated where possible by staff as part of their teaching. This project is part of the Department's ongoing commitment to celebrating EDI in Mathematics and Statistics.
