# Service User Involvement in Social Work Education and Research

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### Some introductory Notes

In the UK and now also in ROI, service user involvement is a mandatory part of the social work curriculum

> Social work education is the most appropriate place for students to most effectively understand the meaning of partnership work with service users. (Gutman et al 2012)

## Opportunities and Challenges

Positive impact on social work students of exposure to service users' lived experiences in social work education, including through research.

Resistance - involving "outsiders" (Banks, 2006) in social work - what kind of knowledge is needed in SW education?

How are service users involved?

Concerns re. tokenism. What does real involvement look like?

# Young People as Educators Project

Rationale - include the voice of marginalised young people in social work education and research

> Aim – to capture young people's experiences of social work involvement in their lives.

> > Process - 3 months; one day a week at the prison; activities; building rapport; planning together – key learning

> > > Outcomes - DVD co-produced as educational tool; positive feedback from all participants

Qualified social workers and service users study and research together

MSc in Research Methods – social workers and service users

Building a culture of evidence and knowledge to inform at policy, management, and practice levels

> User involvement in research priority setting and commissioning structures, research committees, grant-awarding panels and the dissemination and implementation of research findings.

# Developments in Social Work at Maynooth

CORU approval of course - mandatory requirement to demonstrate service user involvement

> Service Users as speakers on 1. own experience 2. presenting research findings 3. participating in focus groups with students to co-produce research

> > Collaboration with Travellers organisations with a view to planning a research project

> > > Long term plans to expand postqualifying course options for social work and (my plan!) is to include service user pathway
