In applying the identity, designers must comply with the Official Languages Act and Regulations, in particular the provisions which require name of the University to appear in Irish only or in both languages on stationery and signage, and should have due regard to equal prominence and frequency of both versions of the logo and a balanced use of both languages on applications.

ENGLISH VERSION - USAGE

The logo comprises of a symbol, the name 'Maynooth University' and the descriptor text 'National University of Ireland Maynooth'. The crest and the text are integral elements of the logo and cannot be separated. The relationship between these elements is fixed and cannot be altered in any way. Master artwork is available.

Note: The Maynooth University logo should be used by all units of the University: faculties, academic departments, schools, administrative departments, research institutes, centres, clubs and societies. This is the only logo that should be used by University units. No other logos should be used.

SYMBOL USAGE

The Maynooth University symbol is based on classic heraldic imagery. The mark combines four images reflecting the University's historical roots and its future. The yew twig and castle refer to the medieval origins of Maynooth and the role played by the Fitzgerald family in the founding of Maynooth and the original college. The yew is also a symbol of regeneration and wisdom. The sundial, a feature at the front of Stoyte House, is a symbol of history, time and enlightenment. The symbol of the open book represents academic learning.

The symbol does not replace the university logo, it must be used in conjunction with it, other than in exceptional circumstances and with the prior approval of the Maynooth University Communications & Marketing Office. The symbol cannot be altered in any way. Master artwork is available.



MAYNOOTH UNIVERSITY IRISH / ENGLISH NAME AND NAMING CONVENTIONS

UNIVERSITY NAME AND TREATMENT

The university name **must** appear in Irish and English on all applications where possible. It is important to follow the below rules when using it.

- > Both languages must be used
- > Irish must come first
- > Where possible differentiate between the languages. The Irish language must always be of equal weight and size to that of the English or the dominant language. This can be achieved with font or colour.
- > The University's Irish and English name must always appear top left or bottom left hand side. See examples of 'top left' on pages 36 and 37.

In all instances "Ollscoil Mhá Nuad" and "Maynooth University" is the preferred name for the University. Where an abbreviation is required "OMH" or 'MU' may be used.

NAMING CONVENTION AND TREATMENT

Maynooth University has a naming convention which is applied to all units of the University: faculties, academic departments, schools, administrative departments, research institutes, centres, clubs and societies.

This convention consists of the name 'Maynooth University' followed by the name of the faculty, academic department, school, administrative unit, research institute, centre, club or society. It is always typeset in the same font size and weight. The rule when using the naming convention is the same as the university name and treatment as listed above.

MAYNOOTH UNIVERSITY WEB ADDRESS AND POSTAL ADDRESS

All website addresses for University units will take the format www.maynoothuniversity.ie/unitname. Projects should also take this format i.e. www.maynoothuniversity.ie/projectname. All new website addresses should be approved by the Maynooth University Communications & Marketing Office.

Maynooth University has a convention for typesetting the university name with its postal address. See examples below.

Where possible on all applications the University name should appear in Irish and English. See examples below.

On print applications, the stacked bilingual treatment of the university name should appear first and in the top left or bottom left corner. It may be used in conjunction with the English logo as shown on the opposite page. For stationery—including letterhead, business cards, compliment slips and envelopes—the black monochromatic version of the stacked treatment should be used. For all other print applications, the following options are permitted:

On a coloured/black background, the stacked white version should be used. See below.

On a white background, either the monochromatic black version may be used or a two-colour version. The two colour version must show the two languages in the same font, weight and size, using one of the university colours for Irish and black for English. See examples on pages 42 and 43.

The following examples show how the English version of the logo must be used in conjunction with the stacked bilingual Maynooth University text.

When the English version of the logo is used it requires the inclusion of the stacked bilingual Maynooth University text.



Use of both logos (Irish and English) on one application (that isn't two-sided) is not allowed.



When the Irish version of the logo is used it does NOT require the inclusion of the stacked bilingual Maynooth University text.



Use of the stacked bilingual Maynooth University text is not permitted with the Irish Logo


APPLICATIONS
