

# TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## Maynooth University International Scholarships 2025 Non-EU Students

### Principle

Maynooth University are offering a limited number of Scholarships to support Non-EU students wishing to register for a Full time Taught Masters programme.

### Eligibility

Applicants must have an offer for a full-time taught master's degree at the University commencing in September 2025.

In order to be considered for a scholarship, students must:

- Have successfully completed their bachelor's degree *or*
- Be in the final year of their bachelor's degree
- Be Non-EU students for tuition fee purposes
- Be in receipt of an offer for their chosen full-time master's degree
- Submit the International Scholarship Form by 15 March 2025

A Maynooth University International Scholarship cannot be combined with any other scholarship award offered by Maynooth University.

### Value

The total value of each Scholarship ranges from €2,000, €2,500 to €5,000. The Scholarship amount will be deducted from your tuition fee obligation.

### Allocation of Scholarship

The scholarship may be awarded for study on a full-time Taught Master's programme at any of the Maynooth University academic departments or research institutes.

### Basis of Award

Scholarships are awarded on a merit basis. Eligible students will be considered for their chosen Master's programme alongside other candidates of that programme. Scholarships will be granted to the student(s) with the highest Bachelor degree result, provided they meet the eligibility criteria outlined above.

### Tenure

A Scholarship is tenable only at Maynooth University in respect of the programme for which it is offered. It may not be transferred to any other programme. The Scholarship is only available in the year/intake in which it is offered. It may not be deferred.

### Condition of Award

To register as a student of Maynooth University on the programme in respect of which the Scholarship is being awarded, by the registration deadline. Failure to complete the registration requirement by the deadline will render the student ineligible for the award without further notice. The individual in receipt of the Scholarship must be attending the programme on a full time basis. If the holder withdraws from the programme for which they have registered or fails to continue throughout the session to meet the

attendance and other requirements of the programme, they will forfeit the Scholarship and will be required to repay to Maynooth University the whole or any part of the Scholarship as may be decided.

Scholarship recipients will be required to participate in marketing activities for Maynooth University postgraduate programmes including testimonials, participation at open events, webinars and social media initiatives.

### **Assessment**

The Scholarship will be administered by the International Office of Maynooth University. The Office will review applications, verify submitted documentary evidence provided and rank eligible applicants according to the academic achievement of the applicant.

The International Scholarships will be awarded to the most highly qualified applicants, separately ranked and based upon the highest overall results in final or penultimate year examinations.

Successful applicants will be contacted in early April 2025.

### **Application Procedure**

Students must have an offer from Maynooth University by 15 March 2025 and complete the International Scholarship Form by 1 March 2025.

### **Payment of Scholarships**

Scholarships will be deducted from your tuition fee obligation.
