

Maynooth University John Pat Hume Doctoral Awards 2018-19

Guide for Referees

Please read this document carefully prior to completing the referee form

1. Introduction

Maynooth University's John and Pat Hume Doctoral Awards scheme is a competitive scheme that supports suitably qualified students intending to undertake a doctoral programme at the University. Evaluation criteria include the applicant's academic record and the quality of research proposal submitted for the competition. References form a crucial part of assessing the applications and it is very important that references are to the point and frank.

Each funding application must be supported by two referees. Applications that are not supported by two references by the specified deadline will be deemed ineligible and excluded from the competition. It is therefore very important that your reference is received by the University's Graduate Studies Office on time by the deadline specified below. Late references cannot be accepted.

Subject to Freedom of Information and Data Protection legislation which is now operational in the University, your reference will be treated as confidential.

2. Deadline for submitting references

Referee forms must be **received by 12 midnight (GMT), 29th March 2019**

3. Guidelines for referees providing "online reference"

Referees providing a reference will:

- a) Enter their details (such as name and contact phone number) into the online system;
- b) Written references must include the following;
 - Name and address of University/Institute where the referee is/was employed. Position held by referee.
 - Relationship between applicant and referee.
 - Please indicate how this applicant compares to other students at the same academic/professional level that you have interacted with – Top 5%, 20%, Above average, below average
 - Please provide your observations on the characteristics and achievements of the applicant. Comment on the suitability of the applicant for a research programme and, potentially, a research career.
- c) Submit their completed reference.

Once an applicant adds you to their application as an online referee, you will receive an email containing:

- a) a link to the login page,
- b) a link to access the Referee form, and
- c) your “personal access code”.

Upon accessing the online system for the first time using the link provided to you in the automated email, you will be asked to create a password. The relevant screen includes instructions regarding password characteristics.




Once you create a password, you will progress to the next screen from which you will access an online form for entering your details and where you will upload your reference.

You do not have to complete and submit your reference in one sitting; you can save the information in the online system and return to your reference later. Below is a snapshot of the login screen that will be presented to you by the system after you create a password:



If you forget/misplace your personal access code or password, click on “Forgot your personal access code or password?” at the bottom of the relevant screen and follow the instructions.

The preferred format for references is PDF. The system supports a number of other formats. Information about supported formats and other technical specifications is displayed when you move the cursor over **“more”**, next to the “Upload Document” button.

Once you upload your completed referee form, you can view it. To view your uploaded form, click at **“view”**.

If you want to replace the form, you can simply upload a new form into the system; it will replace the form uploaded previously. To delete an uploaded referee form, click on the “Delete” (next to “View”, as highlighted on the previous screen snapshot).

Finally, you can review your reference and submit it, from the following screen:

If you are using one of the supported browsers and are experiencing problems, we encourage you to upgrade to the latest version. If you still experience problems after upgrading, please make sure that your browser is set to accept cookies. Also, make sure the following browser settings are enabled:

JavaScript must be enabled.

Popup blockers must be disabled.
