Key messages

- Don't be afraid to change your mind pushing through is not always best deciding to change course can be the most courageous option
- Grades are important going forward
- Choosing a subject solely because there are jobs in that area or because it will look good on your CV is not always wise
- Choose subjects that you like and are interested in will likely do better





Subject Choice... good to know

- Graduate recruiters actively engage with us each year seeking to recruit students
 - Summer Internships
 - Accredited Placements/Internships
 - Graduate Programmes/job
- For many organisations, there is more interest in degree standard and evidence of continuous learning/self development than specific degree subject(s)
- Recruitment cycles begin early in final year (for graduate roles)
- Opportunities to "UpSkill" and develop future focused and work-related skills will be available from first year onwards

Follow interest rather than trying to predict what an employer will want

As a job exploration tool, Prospects Planner aims to help you to:


- · Identify what you want out of a job.

UpSkill Programmes

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Skills for Success - 2nd year Elective Module

- 5 credit module taken in either Semester 1 or Semester 2 of 2nd Year
- Gain an insight into organisational culture and preferred working styles.
- Develop self-awareness and understand the importance of reflective practice and its role in effective, continuous professional development
- Reflect on information to help inform future career planning.
- Structure and articulate ideas effectively, orally and in writing.
- Recognise the skills, qualities and abilities graduate employers seek in employees, and how they are evaluated.
- Identify methods used to assess candidates during selection processes.

SPUR - Summer Programme for Undergraduate Research

- Gain practical research experience that will help you stand out from your peers
- Enhance your personal and professional development
- Applications open in February each year
- Projects take place between June and August
- 6 weeks full time or 12 weeks part time in duration
- Open to pre final year undergraduate MU students
- Apply via Careers Connect



UpSkill Programmes

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MUSE

- Student Experience Award that recognises student contribution beyond the classroom (non-credit bearing activities). Apply via Careers Connect (Applications open in October).
- Must be activities while they were a registered student. Awards ceremony in May for Gold and Platinum awardees.
- Undergraduates and Postgraduates | Any year, any discipline.

Micro-Internships

- Short Term professional work experience opportunities. 20-100 hours typically with professional service
 units in the university.
- Paid at €15.05 per hour. Advertised on Careers Connect during the year.
- Undergraduates and Postgraduates | Any year, any discipline.

Alumni Mentoring –

- Mentored by an alumni that is out in the world of work. Good opportunity to see where your degree can take you. Applications open now, and the mentoring experience takes place between February June.
- Penultimate and Final Year undergraduates.
- Limited number of postgraduate spaces.

Postgraduate Study?

Depending on interests – looking into postgraduate study early can be useful Conversion courses provide options to change direction

For some courses there are steps you can take from $1^{st}/2^{nd}$ year onwards Grades are very important sometimes in 2^{nd} year e.g.
