



Orientation & Registration

Orientation is made up of a number of sessions to introduce all new students to University life. During registration you are formally registered as a Maynooth University student. The following is a quick overview of the sessions:

GREETING BY PRESIDENT

The President of Maynooth University, Professor Philip Nolan, addresses all First Year students to welcome you to Maynooth and to wish you well in your studies and in all aspects of your student life.

REGISTRATION

This is where students formally become a student of the University. All new students must come in person to register.

The registration process involves selection of subjects and modules on-line in a supervised environment and the collection/ amendment of personal details including spellings of names, update of addresses etc.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION

1. Birth Certificate (Please note that your Baptismal Certificate will not serve as a substitute for your Birth Certificate)

OR

Valid Passport (plus State version Marriage Certificate for students who wish to use their married name)

International (Full Degree), Study Abroad, Occasional & Erasmus Students all require a valid passport.

- 2. Your CAO Offer Notice or printout of your offer details from the CAO website, if applicable
- 3. Evidence of Higher Education Grant Award, if applicable
- 4. PPS (Personal Public Service) Number
- 5. Study Abroad and Erasmus Students are required to bring the signed module registration form (provided during orientation welcome talk by International Office) listing their chosen course modules.

NOTE:

If your documents are not available or if the fee payment is incomplete, then you will be registered provisionally. If you are unable to attend at your assigned date and time then check the Records & Registration Office website for late registration schedule.



PAYMENT OF FEES

You will receive by email a set of instructions on how to pay your fees online prior to attending registration. This information will be issued by the Fees Office and will include a user name and password.

Payment of fees alone does not constitute registration. You will be required to attend registration in person.


