



The Post-Graduate Diploma in Educational Leadership (**Tóraíocht**) is offered in partnership by Maynooth University and the Professional Development Service for Teachers (PDST). The course leads to a Level 9 qualification (60 credits).

The course aims to enhance the capabilities of teachers in their current work and to support their preparation for future senior leadership positions. The course is open to fully qualified teachers with a minimum of four years full-time teaching. It encourages colleagues from both primary and post-primary sectors to engage in issues of school leadership together through learning and dialogue while seeking to achieve an overview of the current education system and to recognise the unique contributions that teachers and school leaders can make to the lives of the students in their schools.

The programme is delivered nationally in Education Centres and in the Department of Education at Maynooth University on an annual basis. The following centres have been selected for the academic year 2016/2017:
