



PROFESSIONAL MASTER OF EDUCATION (PRIMARY TEACHING) – SEPTEMBER 2020

Applications are invited from holders of Level 8 degrees or a major award at level 9 or 10 on the National Framework of Qualifications for admission to this full-time 2 year course which will commence in September 2020. A minimum entry requirement of a H2.2 honours Bachelor Degree at Level 8 is required for entry to this course. A limited number of places will be available.

Before applying to the relevant higher education institution(s), prospective applicants are required to take the oral component of the Teastas Eorpach na Gaeilge (TEG) Meánleibhéal 1 (B1) Irish examination. Candidates who have not already registered for the Teastas Eorpach na Gaeilge (TEG) (ORAL) examination, can do so by completing an online application form on www.TEG.ie. Registration is now open and the closing date for TEG applications is 12 noon, Wednesday, 8 January 2020.
