Prof. Peter Hegarty (University of Surrey)

*How do constructed norms affect the ways that we make sense of group differences?
Implications for Gender and Sexual Equality.*



Peter Hegarty is Professor of Psychology at the University of Surrey and visiting Professor at TCD 2015-16. The author of over 100 academic publications, his work bridges social psychology, psycholinguistics, gender and sexuality studies and the history of science. At Surrey, Peter supervises postdoctoral fellows funded by the Wellcome Trust, EU Marie Curie Fellowship, and the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada. His first book *Gentlemen's Disagreement* was published by University of Chicago Press in 2013, and he is currently writing a history of lesbian and gay affirmative psychology to be published by Routledge.
