During my time working for Godolphin, I spent time on three different farms in Lexington, Kentucky. The first farm was their yearling division. Here, I helped the team prep yearlings for the September and October Keeneland sales. In November I got the opportunity to work at Keeneland at the breeding stock sale. The second two farms were Gainsborough where I worked for 3 months and Jonabell, their headquarters, where I worked for 4 months. Here I helped managers with foaling, took mares to the breeding shed and assisted vets and farriers when needed. At Jonabell I was also given the chance to run my own barn of 18 mares and 18 foals.
