



Key features



- Mobility of researchers from all over the world
- Focus on training and career development of researchers
- Participation of non-academic sector strongly encouraged, especially industry and SMEs
- For researchers at every stage of their career
- Coverage for all domains of research (bottom-up approach)
- promotion of attractive working and employment conditions (financing rate of up to 100%)

Innovative Training Networks

What does it offer?

High-quality research training delivered through international and interdisciplinary networks, industrial doctorates or joint doctorates

Who applies?

International networks of research organisations from the academic and non-academic sectors

Who is funded?

Researchers at doctoral level (less than four years of full-time research experience and no doctoral degree)

Individual Fellowships

What does it offer?

Opportunities to work on personal research projects by moving between countries and possibly sectors to acquire new skills

Who applies?

Individual researchers together with the host organisation

Who is funded?

Postdoctoral researchers



RISE

Research and Innovation Staff Exchange

What does it offer?

The exchange of staff members involved in research and innovation to develop sustainable collaborative projects and the transfer of knowledge

Who applies?

International networks of research organisations from the academic and non-academic sectors

Who is funded?

Researchers, technical, administrative and managerial staff of any nationality and at all career levels

Co-Funding of Regional, National and International Programmes

What does it offer?

Regional, national or international programmes to foster excellence in researchers' training, mobility and career development

Who applies?

Organisations funding or managing doctoral programmes or fellowship programmes

Who is funded?

Researchers at doctoral and postdoctoral level

Each researcher - enrolled in a doctoral programme and spend at least 50% in the non-academic sector.

The joint supervision of fellows

The joint supervision of fellows by supervisors from each sector is mandatory.

EJD

European Joint Doctorates

Doctoral programme to deliver joint degrees

Creation of joint doctoral programmes, leading to the delivery of joint, double or multiple doctoral degrees



What are IFs?

 Individual trans-national fellowships to the best and most promising experienced* researchers
 (* with PhD or 4-year full-time equivalent research experience)

For fellows coming to or moving within Europe (12-24 months)

European Fellowships Career Restart Panel (ST) Career Restart Panel (CAR) Reintegration Panel (RI) Society & Enterprise Panel (SE)

Global Fellowships

For fellows coming from Europe to a third country (12-24 months) and returning to Europe (12 months)

- ✓ Secondments of 3 6 months in Europe (MS or AC), for greater impact
- ✓ Specific eligibility criteria
- Career development with an appropriate inter-sectoral dimension





An MSCA-IF PROJECT I

Open to all fields: CHE, SOC, ECO, ENG, ENV, LIF, MAT, PHY

Actors:

- 1 Host institution (beneficiary from MS or AC) (for Global fellowships + 1 partner institution from third country)
- 1 Experienced Researcher (PhD holder or minimum 4years experience in Research) – Any nationality*
- 1 Supervisor

*(residency (condition for nationals of non-Member States/Associated countries for Reintegration panel/Global fellowships)



An MSCA-IF PROJECT II

Activities:

- Training-through-research: individual personalised action
- Hands-on training activities for developing scientific (new techniques, instruments) and transferable skills (proposal preparation, IPR management, task coordination, supervising & monitoring, exploitation of research results)
- Inter-sectoral or interdisciplinary **transfer of knowledge** (secondments)
- Organisation of scientific/training/dissemination events
- Communication, outreach activities
- Training dedicated to gender issues





Global Fellowships (GF)

...before call deadline

1. RESEARCHER RULE

Not If not European, the researcher must have resided at least 5 consecutive years in Europe before leaving (long term residency)



2. MOBILITY RULE

Not resided, worked, studied > 12 months in the 3 years in the country of the **Third Country partner** organisation (outgoing = phase 1)





Widening Fellowships call 2020

Objective: to provide specific support to excellent researchers not funded through the IF call to undertake an individual fellowship in a widening country

Budget: EUR 7 million 2020 from the "Spreading Excellence and Widening Participation" Work Programme.

Widening countries:

Member States: Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia and Slovenia.

<u>Associated Countries:</u> Albania, Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Faroe Islands, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Georgia, Moldova, Montenegro, Serbia, Tunisia, Turkey and Ukraine.



Widening Fellowships call 2019

Evaluation: Proposals from all scientific areas considered for WF funding if:

- submitted to MSCA-IF call by a host organization from a Widening country
- admissible and eligible for MSCA IF-EF (GF excluded)
- obtained a score of 70% or above in the MSCA IF call but was not funded under that call
- have agreed to be considered for WF call

- → One single evaluation performed under MSCA-IF call (the normal award criteria, scoring and thresholds for MSCA-IF will apply)
- → Simultaneous information about MSCA-IF and WF call results



Evaluation Process

- Each proposal is read and evaluated by **three evaluators** in an individual and independent manner. Each evaluator prepares an *individual evaluation report*.
- The three evaluators discuss together to reach a **unanimous consensus** on the final comments and score, and prepare a *consensus report*, containing relevant elements from the three individual reports.
- The consensus score determines the position on the ranking list.
- Applicants receive their *evaluation summary report* (i.e. a copy of the consensus report) in January.

Evaluation Criteria

Excellence	Impact	Quality and Efficiency of Implementation
Quality and credibility of the research/innovation project; level of novelty, appropriate consideration of inter/multidisciplinary and gender aspects	Enhancing the future career prospects of the researcher after the fellowship	Coherence and effectiveness of the work plan, including appropriateness of the allocation of tasks and resources
Quality and appropriateness of the training and of the two way transfer of knowledge between the researcher and the host	Quality of the proposed measures to exploit and disseminate the project results	Appropriateness of the management structure and procedures, including risk management
Quality of the supervision and of the integration in the team/institution	Quality of the proposed measures to communicate the project activities to different target audiences	Appropriateness of the institutional environment (infrastructure)
Potential of the researcher to reach or re-enforce professional maturity/independence during the fellowship		

Each criterion will be scored out of 5. Decimal points will be given.
