

Overview of the Programme Advisory Office

The Programme Advisory Office is available to assist and advise undergraduate students, including incoming first year students, with programme related decisions they may be unsure about before and during the registration period. The Programme Advisory Office acts as a guide to students as they navigate their own way through their programme options. The Programme Advisory Office consists of the Programme Advisor, Caitriona McGrattan, who is supported by a team of PG students during peak times.

Incoming first year students will be briefed by the Programme Advisor during Welcome Week about the programme choices they will be asked to make during their academic journey at Maynooth University. Continuing second year students may also avail of the service if they are unsure about their programme options for example if have any questions about the difference in major/minor pathways or whether or not to choose to take an Elective.

Programme Advisory Team duties include:

- To deliver an information service to 1st & 2nd year undergraduate students on their programme choices and pathways.
- To answer programme choice related questions from via phone, email, ASK (instant messaging system) and in person.
- To provide support and information to students transitioning into third level and transitioning into a new academic year e.g. helping new students negotiate University terminology and processes including the timetable and registration systems.
- To promote the Programme Advisory Office to students and staff, including delivering presentations and creating promotional/informative videos.
