Why legal check?

PROTECTION

•Protect you, the researcher and Maynooth University.



When?



- From the beginning:
- Call Document Funding Programme, Terms & Conditions (T&Cs). Some may not be acceptable to MU.
- Variety of Research Funding sources:
 - Large Funding Agencies (National & European other)
 - Smaller agencies/charities
 - Tenders..(legal submission)
 - Industry
- Partnership with Industry



Developing the Research Proposal



If you collaborate with others as "partners", you may need:

- NDA/Confidentiality Agreement
- Letter of Intent
- MOU
- Subcontractor agreement
- Consortium Agreement
- Declarations



If proposal is successful, then Contracts and Agreements will follow

- If proposal is successful then a contract will be signed.
- Contract "An agreement that gives rise to (rights and obligations) that the law will enforce."
- Contract between MU and Funder. (PI mentioned may be required to countersign)
- Intellectual Property (IP) agreements, licences
- Consortium Agreement
