



Register with Immigration

Study abroad students must register with immigration and get an Irish Residence Permit (IRP Card) AFTER registering with Maynooth University. The process is easy and will be explained to you at orientation. You will be provided with a copy of the immigration presentation after orientation with a detailed description of required documents and to assist you with scheduling an online appointment. You should not book trips to other European cities until you have had your immigration appointment.

Documents for Your Immigration Appointment

Hard copies of the following:

- Valid Passport
- Registration Letter from the International Office (we will have these printed and delivered to immigration)
- Proof of Medical Insurance
- Maynooth University Student ID Card (provided during orientation)
- Immigration Fee of €300- Payments can be made by card or bank giro only. No cash is accepted. Not all foreign bankcards are accepted.
- You must show funds of €500 per month of stay or €3,000 in total if you are staying 6 months or less. Semester students are required to have €1500 in total.

Demonstrating Funds:

1. A statement in respect of an Irish bank account showing sufficient funds
2. A current foreign bank statement, not less than one month old, together with a past statement for an account in the student's name accompanied by a debit card in the same name and same bank account
3. Documentary evidence that money is held in trust for a student by a financial services body regulated in Ireland by the Central Bank of Ireland
4. A pre-paid credit or debit card with a verification of the amount(s) in credit
