Guest Speakers to include Dr. Thomas Walsh (Maynooth University Education department), D. Leah O'Toole (Maynooth University, Froebel Department), Carol Duffy (Early Childhood Ireland), Marie-Claire Chavaroche-Laurent (CEMEA), Dr. Jackie Bourke (University College Dublin) and Christina Duff (Dublin City University).

The symposium is the culmination of a week-long cross cultural exploration, dialogue, and knowledge exchange about outdoor play in Early Childhood Education and Care (ECEC) services in Ireland. It will reflect on the childhood of Ireland's youngest citizens in the 100 years since its declaration of Independence and move forward to offer a re-imagining of, and commitment to, what outdoor play and learning could look like in the next 100 years. It will focus on four main themes:

- The history of childhood and societal views of children in Ireland since 1919
- Children's rights in Ireland since 1919
- Play and early learning in the outdoors
- Spaces for play in the community

We encourage submissions from ECEC Professionals working in services in the sector.
