Arts MH101 to MU Programmes

Automatic, no form or fee required

Subject	Year 2 Option	Progression Requirement
Business	Progress into Year 2 of MH404 Bachelor of Business Studies	Pass double Business (30 credits) or single Business subject (15 credits) + Economics + Accounting *Pass is 40% or more in each module
Law	LLB Single major; BCL Major [Law, 40 credits & Arts subject, 20 credits]	Students who successfully pass 15 credits of Law in 1st year have following transfer options: -LLB Single major -BCL Major
	BCL Double Major BCL Law & Accounting BCL Law & Business	Students who successfully pass 30 credits of Law have these additional options: -BCL Double Major -BCL Law & Business [pass 30 credits of Bus] -BCL Law & Acc: [60% or more in Accounting & take AC160]
	BCL Law & Criminology	-BCL Law &Crim: [pass Criminology]

Subject	Year 2 Option	Progression Requirement	
Accounting	MH403 Accounting & Finance	MH403: 60% in Accounting and 40% in Economics.	
	MH407 Business & Accounting	MH407: 60% in Accounting and 60% in Business.	
	MH502 Law & Accounting	MH502: 60% in Accounting and 40% in Law.	
		*All of the above require AC160	
Economics / Finance	MH401 Finance	50% in Economics/Finance & pass in Accounting	
	MH401 International Finance & Economics	50% in Economics/Finance & pass in Maths

22.5 credits does not make a Double

The difference between a double subject and 22.5 credits in a subject					
Subject Credits	Semester 1	Semester 2	Total		
Double subject	15 credits	15 credits	30 credits		
Single subject & additional module in 2 nd semester	7.5 credits	7.5 + 7.5 credits	22.5 credits		

In general, students who register for 22.5 credits in a subject have the same progression options as a student who studies 15 credits of the subject.

Accounting is an exception to this rule.



MU Programme* to MU Programme

- Internal Transfer request
- Deadline is July 29th 2019
- €10 fee
- Transfers are subject to the availability of places, the student's performance in first year and possibly an interview.

- External Transfer request
- Deadline is July 15th 2019
- €25 fee
- Applications are currently being accepted
