- Account of a job you have held in the Hispanic world or using Spanish. Tips to others who may be seeking work.

These are only a few preliminary thoughts—we will be grateful for further suggestions. Generally, we need material in Spanish, Catalan or Portuguese except for translations from those languages. <u>All</u> levels of proficiency are invited to participate. You should not worry about defects in your command of the language, as I or a colleague will work with you to iron out any problems in your copy.
